







midtgangsbygger Access to this typology is via the central corridor. Some buildings have an open space towards the river to provide more room for deliveries. These buildings had a width of 18 to 36 meters.



dobbeltbrygger Dobbeltbygger had corridors on the north and south sides of the first floor, while on the upper floors the access ran through the middle. The corridors were probably often separated by pillar walls.

This typology was between 26 and 30 meters wide. Today, only one building of this typology remains in



side/midtgangsbryyger
This typology is accessed on the first floor by a side corridor, while the upper floors use central corridors. They were between 14 and 25 meters wide.



sidegangsbrygger In contrast to the side/midtgangbrygger, the sidegangsbrygger had a corridor, which was usually located on the north side. This corridor could be found on all floors except for the top floor, where the corridor was located in the middle.

This typology was the narrowest at 10 to 15 meters.
