
OWNERSHIP: Cooperatives and the City



To take pressure off the rental market and to develop the city whilst maintaining a social perspective the City of Berlin should buy back privatised inner city plots.

These sites could then be given to socially dedicated urban proposals via a concept procedure. The land could remain communal property while letting it under a leasehold contract with a regular rate of return.¹

The structure of a cooperative can offer the legal framework to guarantee socially dedicated housing developments in the long term.²
